PROVIDER CERTIFICATION UPDATE: SERVICES BY APPRENTICE PRACTITIONERS

June 9, 2014

CASOMB has continued to monitor the provider certification application process. We recently reviewed the services which are approved for a Certified Apprentice Practitioner and determined to make the following clarification.

Effective June 9, 2014 the provider certification requirements, Section III, item A, as stated on page 15, is modified as follows:

A. Services which may be provided by a Certified Apprentice Practitioner

A provider certified at the Apprentice Practitioner level may evaluate and treat sexual offenders under the supervision of a Certified Independent Practitioner or Associate Practitioner.

After gaining the initial 30 hours of experience required for certification, an Apprentice may evaluate and treat individuals, families and groups without an Independent or Associate Practitioner present.

A certified Apprentice Practitioner, whether licensed or unlicensed, may not provide supervision for CASOMB purposes.
