CHILD TRAFFICKING

Average age for boys into sexual exploitation is 11-13

Roughly 50% of exploited children in the US identify as boys Exploitation begins at 12-14 years old

San Diego is one of the country's hotspots for trafficking of children CATEGORIES OF TRAFFICKING:

Sex Trafficking

Labor Trafficking

Domestic Servitude

Sex trafficking of juveniles is defined as causing, inducing, persuading, or attempting to cause, induce or persuade a minor to engage in a commercial sex act. ~Penal Code Section 236.1

Sex Trafficking Stats In California

- 98% of children who are sex trafficked had previous involvement with child welfare services
- 24% of traffickers were in foster care at some point when they were a child
- 48% of the interviewed traffickers ran away from home in their youth due to physical or sexual assault.
- 100% of the interviewed ex-traffickers reported that they experienced physical violence in their home or foster care placement.
- 80% of traffickers reported experiencing sexual abuse as a child by a family member, foster care parent, or close family friend.
