



Amendment II to Post-Conviction Sex Offender Polygraph Standards

- 12. Records retention.** The polygraph examination is treatment tool, and an extension of the treatment record. Polygraph examiners should retain all documentation, data, and the recording of each examination for a period of at least seven years or as required by law.
 - 12.1.** If the recording is requested and released to key members of the containment team, the recording shall be retained until the matter is resolved. This may include reviewing the recording with key stakeholders such as members of the containment team, the client, or the conclusion of a legal process. Once the issue that required release of the polygraph examination is resolved, the recording must be consistent with data erasure.
